Degree-Seeking Applicants:

For those documents not uploaded, please send required documents to:

- Complete and electronically submit the online application form
- Submit a statement of intent through the online application system
- Submit a curriculum vitae or resume through the online application
- Arrange for three letters of recommendation to be submitted through the online recommendation system associated with the online application
- Submit the application fee by credit card, check, or money order using the payment system associated with the online application
- Request official transcripts from each post-secondary institution attended and have them directed to the Office of Graduate Admissions
- Arrange for the submission of official Graduate Record Examination (GRE) General Test scores

International Applicants:

In addition to the requirements listed for degree or non-degree applicants above, international students must submit an original-language and an official (i.e. notarized) English translation of each **transcript** to the Office of Graduate Admissions.

Nonnative English Speakers:

Nonnative English speakers must also submit official scores of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
