Options: Study Abroad and Internships

* You must get pre-approval from a faculty advisor and the DUS as well as enroll in an internship course before the internships begins. For an unpaid internship you can get up to 3 credits. ** We will accept 6 credits toward your major taken from a study abroad program (only one of the two courses can be in art history). You must meet with the Office of International Studies and get approval from the DUS before applying.
